

LIGHTING OF THE PASCHAL CANDLE


Leader: This candle reminds us of Christ's presence in Barbara's life and of the light she was to us and those to whom she ministered.


ALL: May Christ, the eternal and unfading light, now welcome her into the Kingdom of Light and Peace.

All: May Barbara now share eternal life with God in glory.






God of all creation we gather to farewell

one God forever & ever.



said: See, this is our God in whom we hoped.








A Reading from the letter to the Romans. With God on our side who can be against us? Since God did not spare his own Son but gave him up to benefit us all, we may be certain, after such a gift, that he will not refuse anything he can give. Could anyone accuse those that God has chosen? When God acquits, could anyone condemn? Could Christ Jesus? No! He not only died for us- he rose from the dead, and there at God's right hand he stands and pleads for us. Nothing therefore can come between us and the love of Christ. even if we are troubled or worried, or being persecuted, or lacking food or clothes, or being threatened or even attacked. These are the trials through which we triumph, by the power of him who loved us. For I am certain of this: Neither death nor life, no angel, no ruler, nothing that exists, nothing still to come, not any power, or height or depth, nor any created thing, can ever come between us and the love of God made visible in Christ Jesus our Lord.

COMMUNION HYMN We Walk By Faith


We walk by faith, and not by sight:





Leader: Eternal rest, grant unto her, O Lord, And let perpetual light shine upon her. **Response:**






Welcome home! Welcome home!

Let us pray for those who mourn. Comfort them in their grief. Lighten their sense of loss. All: Gracious God in your mercy hear our prayer.


We pray together in the words Jesus gave us.


