The power, and the glory,

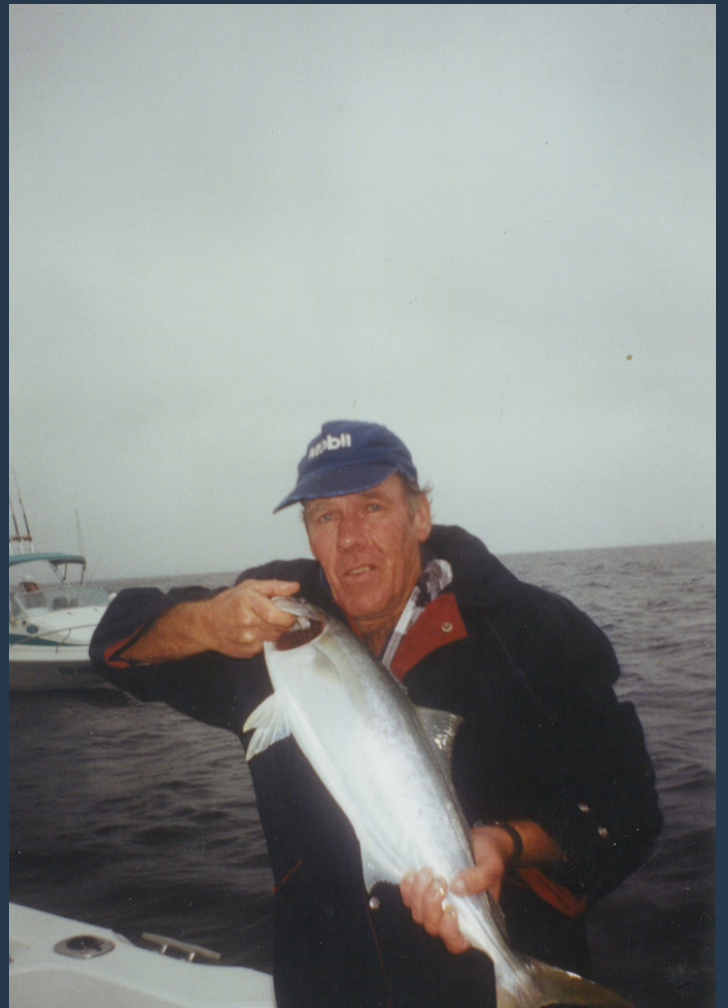
